Application Stages

Eligibility to Apply

- Registered as an active student at home university;
- Have completed at least one academic year of study at home university;
- Nominated officially by home university (an official coordinator's full name and email address is required);
- Have good academic standing with CGPA not less than 3.0 or equivalent; and
- Have good command of English in speaking and writing.

English Language Requirements

- Students who are interested in taking modules at the Faculty of Business & Accountancy (FBE) and Faculty of Law (FOL) are required to fulfil either one of the English requirements below:

Min. Score	Band 6	80	550	214	550	690	B2

- A Support/Recommendation Letter issued by the Home University's Coordinator to confirm the student's english proficiency will be sufficient for those who wish to study modules from other faculties except FBE & FOL.

Important Application Documents

- Recent Passport Size Photograph (Pure White Background)
- Latest Academic Result/Transcript (must be in English)
- A copy of the student's passport (front page with ID)
- English language Examination Result
- Recommendation Letter issued by home university (Click [here](#) for template)
 - Confirm your student's enrolment status at home university
 - Recommendation to participate for mobility programme at UM
 - Scholarship/Sponsorship details (if applicable)

Module Selection & Approval

1. There will be a module registration week before the semester begins for you to register the modules based on the available capacity and timetable.
2. Students are advised to have alternative modules to register for in case their initial choices are at maximum capacity.
3. Also, students cannot enrol in clashing classes, so students are advised to be prepared with alternative options before the module registration started.

Few things to take note:

- ❑ Undergraduate students are not eligible to take postgraduate modules, but Postgraduate students are allowed to take both undergraduate and postgraduate modules.
- ❑ It is mandatory for students to register a minimum of 6 credits (2 modules) and up to a maximum of 20 credits (6-7 modules).

Important Note:

- ❑ It is the student's responsibility to make sure the online form is filled up accordingly. Please note that incomplete application will not be processed and is deemed unsuccessful.
- ❑ Universiti Malaya from time to time will notify home university's coordinator's regards to any matter related to student mobility programme.
- ❑ All fees charged to the student will be stated in the offer letter issued by the Universiti Malaya. The Universiti Malaya will not be responsible for any service fees charged by any third party (agents etc).


